

Water-testing at the Mildura Rural City Council Landfill Site

Mission:

To assist MRCC with establishing the suitability of recycled stormwater for municipal irrigation purposes.

Background:

During this project water-testing was carried out at the Mildura Rural City Council (MRCC) Landfill site to assess the quality of stormwater prior to (and following) treatment with Iodine. The treated water was assessed to establish its suitability for a variety of non-potable purposes around the Landfill site.

Students enrolled in the Certificate III in Conservation and Land Management, the NCS Project Officer and the Centre for Land, Food and Water, Laboratory Technician carried out testing and provided a report to the MRCC.

Objective:

The objective of the project was to provide the MRCC with scientifically valid results in relation to the quality of the pre and post-treated water for non-potable purposes.

The involvement of the Conservation and Land Management students in the project helped in achieving educational outcomes while providing useful data for the Mildura Rural City Council.
