

Supporting Sustainable Natural Resource Management, Biodiversity and Indigenous Conservation

October 3rd 2007 - Envirofund Round 9.

Envirofund has two main objectives:

- to provide the opportunity and means for community groups to undertake small on-ground projects tackling important local problems; and
- to provide a mechanism through which community groups can move towards effective engagement in broader regional approaches to natural resource management.

The project will focus on traditional knowledge and customs relating to natural resource management. Tangible on-ground benefits include the planting of 1,500 indigenous native species to restore and support isolated patches of indigenous vegetation. Outcomes will be measured through a series of photographs and results from feedback sheets from participants at workshops.
