The Swan Hill campus will institute water saving principles and techniques throughout the day to day running of the campus, and value add to existing sustainability programs.

The project will bolster water saving efficiency measures, support and promote a clear community benefit.

We will collaborate with partners, industry and community groups to raise awareness and improve the sustainability and efficiency of water resources, supply and use.

Activities include:

- Rainwater Harvest & Collection – Rainwater tanks
- Re-supply a portion into toilets for re-use
- Lawn conversion into native plantings
